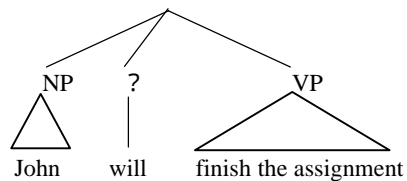


2.4.4. 節の構造

- (1) NP のテスト :
- Clefting:
It is [NP John] that will finish the assignment.
 - Sentence fragments:
"Who will finish the assignment?" "[NP John]."
 - Coordination:
[NP John] and [NP the student who came here yesterday] will finish the assignment.
 - Pronominalization:
[NP He] will finish the assignment.
- (2) VP のテスト :
- Pseudo-clefting:
What John did was [VP finish the assignment].
 - Preposing:
John promised that he will finish the assignment, and [VP finish the assignment] he will. (Radford 1988:101 (168a))
 - Coordination:
John will [VP finish the assignment] and [VP hand it in]. (Radford 1988:101 (168c))
 - Shared Constituent Coordination:
John will, and Mary may, [VP finish the assignment].
 - Pronominalization:
John will [VP finish the assignment], and *so* will Mary. (Radford 1988:101 (168b))
 - Ellipsis:
Paul won't [VP finish the assignment], but John will ~~finish the assignment~~. (Radford 1988:101 (168d))

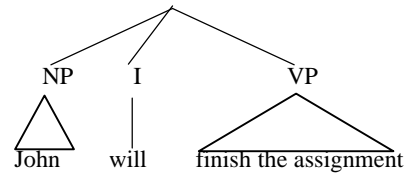


- [NP John] **may** [VP finish the assignment].
 - [NP John] **must** [VP finish the assignment].
 - [NP John] **did not** [VP finish the assignment].
 - [NP John] **DID** [VP finish the assignment].
 - [NP John] **DOES** [VP finish the assignment].
- John **finished** the assignment.
 - John **finishes** the assignment.
- Paul **finished** the assignment, and John will ~~finish the assignment~~.

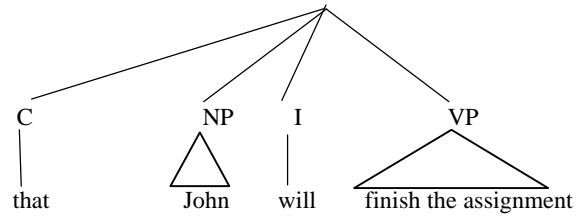
- Paul **finished** the assignment, but I did not ~~finish the assignment~~.

 - *It is necessary [that [NP John] **to** [VP finish the assignment]].
 - I am anxious [that [NP John] **should** [VP finish the assignment by Friday]].
 - *I am anxious [that [NP John] **to** [VP finish the assignment by Friday]].
 - I hope [that [NP Thelma] **will** [VP dance after lunch]]. (Haegeman & Gueron 1999:94 (167a))
 - *I hope [that [NP Thelma] **to** [VP dance after lunch]].
- *It is necessary [for [NP John] **will** [VP finish the assignment]].
 - It is necessary [for [NP John] **to** [VP finish the assignment]].
 - *I am anxious [for [NP John] **should** [VP finish the assignment by Friday]].
 - I am anxious [for [NP John] **to** [VP finish the assignment by Friday]].
 - *I hope [for [NP Thelma] **will** [VP dance after lunch]].
 - I hope [for [NP Thelma] **to** [VP dance after lunch]]. (Haegeman & Gueron 1999:94 (167b))
- (9) 定形節
that に続くことはあっても、for に続くことはない。
It is necessary [that John will finish the assignment].
*It is necessary [for John will finish the assignment].
主語は主格となる。
It is necessary [that he will finish the assignment].
*It is necessary [that him will finish the assignment].
- (10) 不定節
for に続くことはあっても、that に続くことはない。
It is necessary [for John to finish the assignment].
*It is necessary [that John to finish the assignment].
主語は目的格となる。
It is necessary [for him to finish the assignment].
*It is necessary [for he to finish the assignment].
- C(omplementizer)** という範疇を仮定する。
 - that は [+finite] の C である。
 - for は [-finite] の C である。
- I(nflection)** という範疇を仮定する。
 - will などの法助動詞・現在形 / 過去形の区別を表す語 / 接尾辞・主語との一致要素(いわゆる3単現の -s など)は [+finite] の I である。
 - to は [-finite] の I である。
- C と I は [±finite] に関して一致していなければならない。

b. [+finite] の場合には主語は主格となるが、[-finite] の場合には目的格となる。

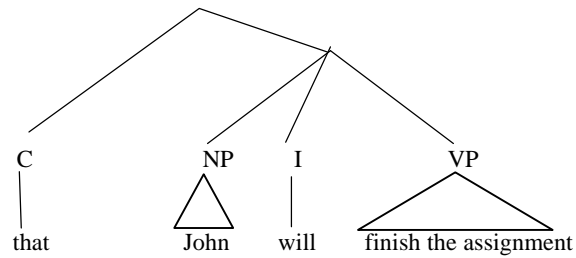

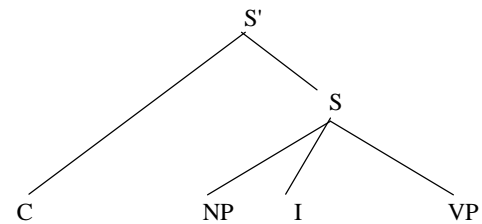

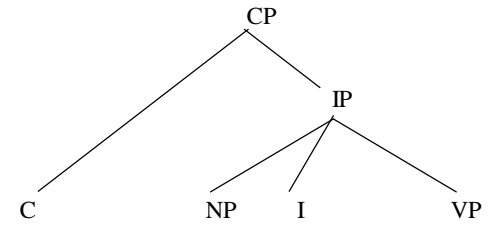
(16) Shared Constituent Coordination:
